Eligibility

Any Kansas high school student planning to major in, or current Kansas undergraduate student majoring in, agronomy, crop science, ag engineering, professional ag-chemical application or a related field of study. These scholarships are available to students planning to attend or currently enrolled at any university, junior college, community college or technical school in the state of Kansas. This is a one-time scholarship, but winners may re-apply for the scholarship after the first year. Applicants should be self-starters, have a good academic standing, be good school and community citizens and have a strong desire to continue their education.

Any undergraduate student majoring in agronomy at Kansas State University **who will be enrolled as a junior or senior in the 2012-2013 school year.**
